#### Article 1

### OBJECTIVE OF COOPERATION

The objective of this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is to cooperate each other in educational projects in areas of mutual interest

#### Article 2

### SCOPE OF COOPERATION

#### Article 3

### FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENT

Any cooperation under this MOU is subject to the availability of funding sources and approval of therelevant authorities.

#### Article 4

### LOCATION OF ACTIVITIES

1. The Parties agree to implement the programmes stated in Article 2 at Maharaja Manindra Chandra College and Naba Ballygunge Mahavidyalaya.
2. Any changes of the location of the programmes shall be mutually agreed upon by the Parties.

#### Article 5

### MODE OF CONDUCTING THE PROGRAMMES

The programmes will be conducted primarily in the Offline mode. Ample arrangements should also be made to conduct programmes in the online mode if required.

#### Article 6

### DURATION AND TERMINATION

- 1) This MOU shall enter into force on the date of signing.
- 2) The MOU shall remain in force for a period of five (5) years and may be extended for another period of five(5) years by the mutual written consent of the Parties.
- 3) Either Party may terminate this MOU at any time by giving written notice to the other Party on its intention to terminate this MOU, at least six (6) months prior to the date of the termination.
- 4) The termination of this MOU shall not affect the completion of any project/s and programme/s in progress and not completed at the time of termination.

#### Article 7

### AMENDMENT

- 1) This MOU may be amended or revised at any time by mutual written consent of the Parties and such amendment shall form an integral part of this MOU.
- 2) Such amendment/s or revision/s shall come into force on the date as may be determined by the Parties.



Any dispute concerning the interpretation and/or application of this MOU shall be settled amicably through consultations or negotiations between the Parties.





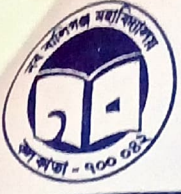
