Report of the Webinar

On 15th November 2021 the department of History in collaboration with the department of Political Science organised a webinar on the Taliban Takeover of Afghanistan: its regional and international implications. Professor Bimal Shankar Nanda of Charuchandra college and Professor Aneek Chatterjee of Hooghly Mahosin college graced the webinar as the Speakers.
