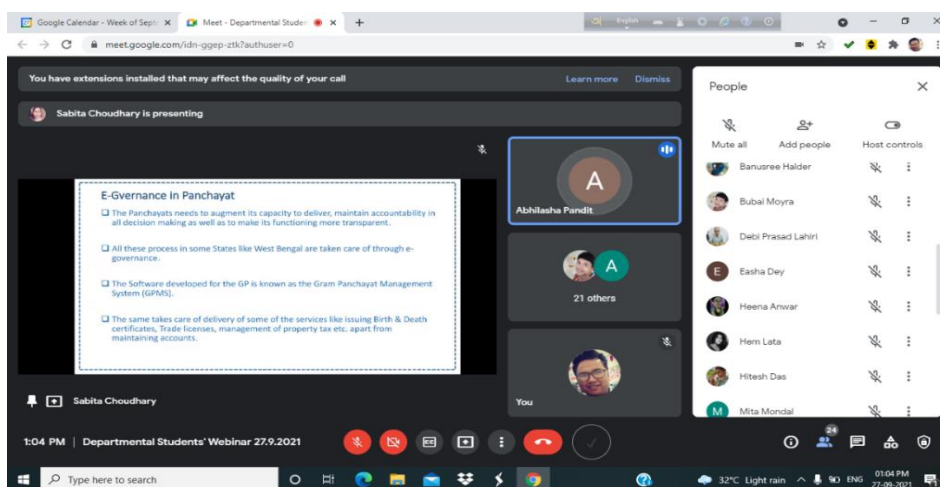

On September 27, 2021, the Department of Political Science at Naba Ballygunge Mahavidyalaya hosted a webinar for departmental students titled "Democracy in India: Issues and Challenges." The webinar focused on several concerns and difficulties facing Indian democracy. The webinar began at 11 a.m. with a welcome by Shri Gouranga Roy, Head of the Department of Political Science. Dr. Sukamal Datta, principal of Naba Ballygunge Mahavidyalaya, delivered the opening remarks and keynote address. He outlined a number of obstacles confronting the Indian democracy, including social and economic inequality, unemployment, the caste system, communalism, and corruption, and he underlined that these obstacles must be addressed in order to preserve genuine democracy in India. Thereafter, Dr. Avijit Sutradhar, Assistant Professor, Department of Political Science, Islampur College, who also chaired the Webinar's Technical Session, discussed his research efforts and expertise on the topic. He explained how the Indian democracy faces several obstacles. He also provided some thoughts on how to make the Indian democracy more successful. Seven groups of students (each with four members) presented their papers during the Webinar.
